

Our free DIY table numbers coordinate with some of our most popular wedding invitation designs. You can print them at home or send our print template to your local print or copy center and have them print it for you. Crop marks are provided on each page so that you can cut them out at home: you'll need a craft knife, ruler (ideally metal), and cutting mat (or a magazine), or you can use a paper cutter. Our table numbers are flat and one-sided, and meant to be displayed in a metal stand (which your caterer or venue should be able to supply). For a 2-sided card, simply cut out two of each number and paste them together with double-sided tape or a glue stick. For a folded card, you can purchase A4 paper cards from stationery store to create a table tent, and affix the table numbers to each side of the tent.

### MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

Printer

Cardstock A5 size

Craft knife (or paper cutter)

Cutting mat (or a magazine)

Straight edge ruler (preferably metal)

1 Print out PDF template.

2 On a cutting mat or a magazine, using a straight edge ruler and a craft knife, trim out each table number using the crop marks as your guides.
